
KINGSLEY – BATE Fine Garden Furniture ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE TR - 37







LEGS



Unpack, inspect and lay the parts on a clean, flat, soft surface to avoid marring the wood.

NOTE: During assembly of the furniture please match all joints with the corresponding letters or numbers stamped on the furniture.

***NOTE:** A TENON B MORTISE HOLE



STEP-II

STEP-I

Place the TABLE TOP face down and carefully insert the LEG tenons into their respective mortise holes on the underside of the TABLE TOP. Tenons of the LEGS will be stamped with a number or letter to correspond with their respective mortise holes on the BASE.





STEP-III

Carefully take the BASE and insert the LEG tenons into their respective mortise holes. Again, please be sure to line up the stamped numbers or letters. Using a rubber mallet or a regular hammer with a wood block between the hammer and the wood, drive the tenons and mortise holes together until all the joints fit snugly together. Drive the wooden dowels through

the tenons of the LEGS using direct sharp blows from a hammer. To avoid marring the wood please use a block of wood between the dowel head and the hammer head for the last few blows. Do not force dowels; any excess can easily be sanded away.



STEP-IV

Drive the remaining dowels into the BASE using the same care used in STEP III. Again, do not force the dowels. Any excess can easily be sanded away.



STEP-V

Insert all screws into pre-drilled holes using a proper screw driver as shown in the diagram.



STEP-VI

Place the table upright and insert all screws into pre-drilled holes using a proper screw driver as shown in the diagram. Cover the screw holes with the teak plugs provided. Tap them in carefully with a hammer.
